# Hosterman's Pit Status Report

The effort to save Hosterman's Pit from being destroyed from mining entered a new phase since my last report. On Feb. 23, the Independent Regulatory Review Commission (IRRC) sent their stage one comments to the Pa. Dept. Environmental Resources (DER). They asked that DER address three specific items. 1) Why is Hosterman's Pit unique? 2) Why was Stover #2 included in the proposal?, and 3) What "interest" (in the legal sense) does the Nittany Grotto have in the cave. DER had already addressed points 1 and 3, and the IRRC was just asking for clarification.

According to the law which governs this aspect of the regulatory review process, DER has up to two years to respond. I feel that the response will come this summer.

After DER responds, the IRRC will hold a public meeting where persons can speak for or against the proposal. In a related matter, late in 1992 the Penns Valley Conservation Association filed a petition to have portions of Elk and Pine Creeks upgraded to Exceptional Value. If this happens, the water quality would not be allowed to be degraded. Increase in temperature, introduction of sedimentation, or change in pH would be disallowed. This would probably require the mining company to drastically change their mining plans.

The upgrade petition is scheduled to be acted upon by the Environmental Quality Board in June.

We have been encouraged by the number of letters which have been already sent to the IRRC asking them to save the cave. If you have been putting it off, you still have time to write. The IRRC is impressed by the amount of mail it receives, because that helps them judge the importance of an issue to the citizens of the Commonwealth. Of course, if you live outside Pennsylvania and have visited Hosterman's Pit, your letter certainly counts. So if you haven't yet written, here is the address.



#### DIRECTIONS

Harrisburg and points East-take Rte.22 West through Water Street, PA. Go 9 miles to the crossroads of Yellow Springs, PA. Turn left and drive for 4 miles, following signs. Turn left into the Community Center.

Pittsburgh and points West - take Rte 22 East through Hollidaysburg, PA. Go 9 miles to the intersection of 22 and Rte. 866. Bear to the right onto Rte 866. Continue on for 4 miles, into Williamsburg. At the first stop sign, turn left, over the bridge and follow signs, turning right into the Community Center.

From all points South - Make your way to Bedford, PA. Follow Rte. 220 Nouth for 30 miles to the intersection of Rte.22. Turn onto Route 22 East at Hollidaysburg, PA. Go East for 9 miles to the intersection of Rtes. 22 and 866. Bear right on Rte 866. Continue on for 4 miles into Williamsburg. At the first stop sign, turn left, over the bridge and follow signs, turning right into the Community Center.





LLSoft is a computer program designed to aid in the determination of latitude and longitude using map-edge measurements of USGS 7.5 minute topographic maps for Pennsylvania.

- 1. A PC-compatible computer with DOS and a minimum of 356K, A hard disk is not necessary.
- 2. A USGS 7.5 minute topographic map for an area within the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. (As currently designed, the program will only work for PA.)
- An engineering scale or other measuring device.

The cost is \$10. (Plus 6% sales tax in PA) Make checks payable to Keith D. Wheeland.
